



My name is Paul White and I am now the new chaplain for Kimberley School of the Air (KSOTA) as Jonathon Spurgeon the previous chaplain has passed the banner onto me. I'm really looking forward to catching up and meeting some of

you at the school camp down in Broome next Monday afternoon. I was raised in Derby, went to school up here in the Kimberley and married my wife Laurel 47 years ago in Derby. Since then we have raised our 4 children and now enjoy spending time with our 13 grandchildren as well.

We commenced a flying ministry called "Kingdom Aviation Ministries" in the Kimberley 17 years ago and operate 4 planes and have our own permanent aeroplane hanger based in Derby.
