#### Travel and visits

I thought that it was an opportune time with the start of a school year and some new families that I took this opportunity to revisit our school's processes surrounding teacher visits to families.

It is our commitment that each family will get 2 home visits per year from the school. Usually it will be the teachers of the children who make the visit. Sometime I will accompany visits and sometimes the STL (Esther Kerr) will be on the visit. The visits duration and who is on the visit will always be negotiated with the family. Some visits will be a day visit and others will involve the visiting staff staying over night/s. The duration is directly linked with where the family lives and the distances required to travel.

Whilst teachers are on the visit the school will endeavour to cover the Air Lessons using Miss Kerr and/or myself. Individual lessons will be cancelled for the class during visits.

There may be occasions where Air Lessons are cancelled as there is just not the staff to cover them.

New families who have queries about Home Visits are free to call me. Please note Miss Kerry will be sending out the Yearly Consent Forms, which include a Home Visit consent section, soon.
